This year we have three openings for Board membership.

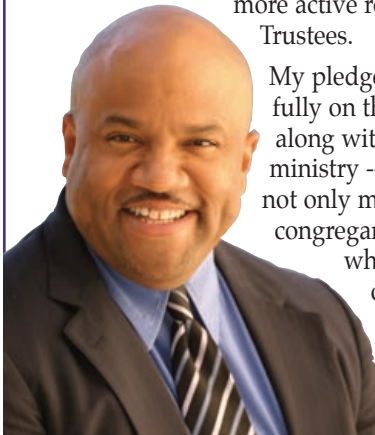
Following are the current candidates who are running to fill those openings.
